

**Curious about the Buffalo BLM Proposed Resource Management Plan?
Attend Public Meetings This Month!**

The Buffalo Field Office of the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) recently released a proposed revision to its Resource Management Plan (RMP). The plan governs the management of BLM land and mineral resources in Sheridan, Johnson, and Campbell Counties (aka the Powder River Basin). Leasing of coal, development of uranium, promotion of recreation opportunities, wildlife protection, and of course oil and gas are all on the table in the new plan.

BLM is hosting public meetings on its new plan in Buffalo, Sheridan, Kaycee, and Gillette. Please plan to attend a meeting to learn more about the plan and ask questions of BLM staff and its consultants about the various management options they are considering. The BLM will be holding presentations during the meeting and will have information tables with various resource area specialists. There will also be a computer where you can submit comments or a form you can fill out there or take home with you to submit comments.
